

INTERNATIONAL BACHELOR PROGRAMME IN ECONOMICS AND MANAGEMENT

The Faculty of Economic and Social Sciences of the Lille 1 University has created an **international bilingual English-French programme for the Bachelor in Economics and Management**.

This programme with ***selective admissions*** criteria is made for students with a good level of English, and who would like to open their mind to the European and international dimensions of the economy in the spirit of the European high schools. It is also aimed at students who would like to embrace international careers. The students are immersed in a group of international students who take English courses. Half of the classes will be taught in English. Finally, it will be easier for students who have completed the international bachelor programme to pursue higher education abroad within European (ERASMUS) and international mobility programmes. They will also be able to join international Master programmes, here in Lille, or abroad. The number of students who can be accepted into these programs is limited to 36. The third year of the programme will run from September 2016. ***Students involved into this programme will be invited to pursue their third year abroad.***
